a modern renaissance

Albany Rural Cemetery is listed on the National Register of Historic Places and is one of the most beautiful and historic cemeteries in the United States. Still an active cemetery, its trustees are committed to preserving the historic landscape, buildings and monuments of this important local landmark. Recent projects include footfall odds and restoration of monuments that have fallen due to forces of nature and landscape renewal. New areas have also been developed, including the Linden Grove Cremation Garden, Consecration Garden, which is free from traditional headstones, and the Mausoleum Chapel, a modern addition to the historic Romanesque Chapel.
